then £1 for every 30 minutes thereafter up to the maximum stay. Drivers must still obtain a ticket or register their vehicle for the first free 60 minutes by machine, phone or by using the kiosk in the Storey's Field Centre.

A MAXIMUM STAY OF 4 HOURS APPLIES ON EDDINGTON AVENUE

(2 hours for spaces elsewhere at Eddington)

NO RETURN WITHIN TWO HOURS ON EDDINGTON AVENUE

(no return within 1 hour where maximum stay is 2 hours)

CASHLESS PAYMENT TERMINALS are placed in three locations across Eddington for visitors to pay for their parking – marked on the map with blue hexagons. Drivers are also able to pay by phone with Redde (phone call, text or mobile app). There is also a kiosk in the Storey's Field Centre where drivers can pay for their parking.

BLUE BADGE HOLDERS can park for free without using the machines or Redde app in marked disabled bays only and when displaying a parking clock. Maximum stay limits apply. Tariffs and restrictions apply for all non-disabled bays.

PARKING CHARGE NOTICES will be issued to drivers, including Blue Badge holders, for parking violations, including but not limited to:

- · Parking on double yellow lines
- · Parking in a disabled bay without a valid Blue Badge
- Parking in a permit holder area without a valid permit
- · Parking without a valid ticket, even for the first hour
